

## VISITOR REGULATIONS

### Basic provisions

1. The Forum 2000 Foundation, with its registered seat at Hrad, 119 08 Prague, ID: 65992768, as the organizer (hereinafter referred to as the "**Organizer**") of the Forum 2000 Conference (hereinafter referred to as the "**Event**"), issues these Visitor Regulations with reference to the obligations as imposed by the corresponding laws.
2. The Visitor Regulations determine the binding code of conduct for all visitors who enter the Event space, in particular those entering in order to attend this Event.
3. The purpose of the Visitor Regulations is to ensure the safety of visitors, to protect their health and property, and to ensure the protection of the facilities and all property located on the Event premises.
4. By entering the Event premises, each visitor acknowledges that they are required to comply with all the rules and conditions set out in the Visitor Regulations and agrees to observe and comply with them.
5. Every individual entering the Event area agrees without any further notice to the free use of their image or voice as part of an audiovisual recording, transmission or reproduction for commercial and promotional purposes in the portrayal of all or part of the Event and in connection with the Promoter's Events and its partners and collaborators.

### Entry and staying on the Event premises

1. Visitors are allowed entrance onto the Event premises and are permitted to stay only after successfully completing the on-line registration by September 29, 2017, and presenting an ID card or a similar document issued by state authorities to verify their identity on site.
2. The visitor is obliged to present an ID or a similar document at any time at the request of the Organizer, the security services, or members of the Czech Police. A visitor who fails to prove their right to stay at the Event is obliged to leave the Event area without delay. Otherwise, they acknowledge that they will be escorted off the Event premises.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry or to escort off the premises any person whose actions are in breach of the law, the Visitor Regulations, or any other internal regulations governing the operation of the Event. Any person who fails to obey the Organizer's instructions or the security services or an individual, who is

clearly under the influence of alcohol or other addictive substances, will also be denied entry, asked to leave, or escorted off the premises.

4. Every visitor entering the Event area agrees to personal checks of their person and, at the same time, control of their luggage and belongings to be performed by authorized personnel or by the Czech Police. The failure to comply may be a reason to deny access to the Event area.

### **Visitor obligations during the Event**

1. Every visitor is obliged to behave on the Event premises in such a manner that their actions do not endanger the safety of other persons and their property and do not damage the equipment or property located on the Event premises. They are also obliged to behave in such a manner that they do not disrupt the well-being of or cause discomfort to others and do not act contrary to good morals.
2. Every visitor is obliged to behave in the Event areas so as not to interfere with public order, such as loud and disturbing manifestations, the use of all degrading or offensive expressions and gestures regarding race, religion or ethnicity, manifestations with significant sexual character or sexual subtext, and any other manifestations which could result in disturbances.
3. Every visitor is obliged to follow the regulations and instructions of the security services, members of the Czech Police, the fire brigade, the rescue service, etc.
4. Every visitor is obligated to wear the conference badge which they receive upon registration in a visible place on their person during the course of the Event.
5. Every visitor is obliged to report immediately to the Organizer any observed risks and any violations of the generally binding regulations or the Visitor Regulations.

### **Prohibitions**

On the Event premises it is prohibited:

- a) to carry weapons of any kind, as well as objects which may be used as weapons;
- b) to bring alcohol, drugs or other toxic substances;
- c) to smoke outside of designated areas;
- d) to bring non-foldable or bulky items, including large backpacks, suitcases and bags;
- e) to bring pressurized containers;

- f) to enter areas which are not intended for visitors;
- g) to use open fire;
- h) to distribute any printed or commercial or promotional materials not expressly approved by the Organizer;
- i) to conduct business, advertising or other commercial activity without the prior permission of the Organizer;
- j) to make sound or video recordings of the program using any technological device, unless the Organizer specifies otherwise;
- k) to in any way fail to keep the Event premises or the facilities located in these areas clean or damage them;
- l) to discard garbage outside the wastebasket.

### **Organizer**

1. The monitoring and supervision of the security of persons and property, as well as supervision of compliance with applicable laws and regulations, including the Visitor Regulations, are the responsibility of the Organizer.
2. The Organizer is authorized to issue binding instructions to ensure the purpose for which the Event was set up and to ensure the smooth running of the event.
3. In addition to the Organizer, the security services are also entitled to supervise and issue instructions. Within its legal jurisdiction, this authority also belongs to the Czech Police.

### **Liability for damages and consequences of violation of the Visitor Regulations**

1. Every visitor enters and stays on the premises at their own risk. The Organizer is responsible only for the damage to health or property caused by intentional or grossly negligent behavior of the Organizer's employees or persons affiliated in a similar manner.
2. Persons, who in any way violate the provisions of the Visitor Regulations, may be denied access to the Event until further notice.
3. Compensation for any damage caused by a visitor will be enforced in accordance with applicable law (i.e. as a result of a penalty by the owner of the premises or technical equipment by state authorities, cancellation of the event, etc.).
